

# Singles Free Skate Invitational Competition & Pairs Showcase Rules and Regulations 25<sup>th</sup> June 2022

## 1. <u>General</u>

- 1.1 The personal details supplied by competitors on the application form will be held on computer files and used solely for the purposes of organising the competition.
- **1.2** The competition will be judged using the International Judging System (IJS). The scores will not be announced after each skater but may be available at a later date should you wish feedback on your performance.
- **1.3** Oxford Ice Rink / Figure Skating Club does not accept any responsibility for any loss of personal property or personal injury during this event.
- **1.4** Competitors, Parents and spectators are reminded that the Organisers, Helpers, Judges and Officials are all volunteers, without whom this competition would not be possible, please treat them with the respect and politeness they deserve.



## 2. Entry details

2.1 The competition classes are based on the current level you skate at but may be sub-divided by age if there are too many entries for one class.

All information regarding the programme requirements can be found in the Generic Criteria July 2021 to 30 June 2022 published on the BIS website.

2.2 The official Entry forms must be used.

The section on the Planned Programme Contents Sheet is required for all skaters. Please complete this (timings are not required but the correct order of the elements are). This is a requirement of the form and the form can not be completed without the elements added.

- **2.3** Entries to the competition will be treated strictly on a first received basis and will only be accepted on receipt of the full entry form, completed Programme Content sheet and payment confirmation.
- 2.4 Entry fee is £25 per skater payable via PAYPAL to the following email address: <u>oxf.entries@gmail.com</u>
  All entries must reach the competition organiser by 5PM on the closing date of Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022. No Late or verbal entries will be accepted.

### 3. Competition Information

- **3.1** All competitors must be ready to skate at least 20 minutes before the time stated on the timetable. Please be ready to skate when your name is announced, any late skaters may be disqualified.
- **3.2** The list of successful competitors and a provisional timetable will be emailed out to competitors supplied email addresses as soon as possible after the closing date.
- **3.3** All music must be emailed to: <u>oxf.entries@gmail.com</u> Please save the music as an MP3 with the level entered and skater's full name for singles, e.g.

Please ensure there is a spare CD copy of your music rink side with your coach playable on a standard CD player.

**3.4** Taking photographs with a flash is exceptionally dangerous for the skaters and distracting for the officials (and other spectators) and will not be tolerated, anyone failing to abide by this may be asked to leave the area.
